AMENDMENT A05508
SPONSOR: Sen. Gordner

The amendment is mostly technical in nature, with two exceptions.

As introduced, the legislation calls for licensing of PEO's by the Department of Labor and Industry. The amendment changes the licensing entity to the Department of State, since DOS registers and licenses other entities. The Department of Labor and Industry will remain responsible for oversight over the workers' compensation, unemployment insurance and other labor-related areas of the act.

Further, rather than establishing registration fees as provided for in the legislation, the Department of State would have the ability to establish fees for application and renewal of PEO's by regulation. Such fees shall not exceed the actual amount necessary for administration of the act.
